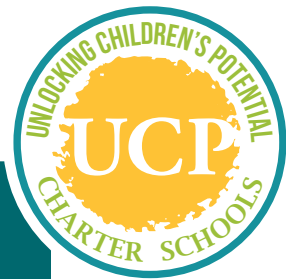


GIVE YOUR CHILD AN Early Head Start!

If you qualify for SNAP Benefits, and your child is age eligible, you automatically qualify for this **FREE** program!*



Early Head Start is a federally funded program that provides free services to support early learning and development, health, and well-being for families that meet certain criteria and have children from birth to age 3.

What is Provided?

Early Care & Education

We provide free, full-day (10 hours) early education for children from birth to age 3 for the full year

Pregnancy Services

We connect families with community resources that provide support with accessing food, housing, mental health services and other resources

Nutrition Services

We provide FREE healthy meals for children and access to nutrition supports for families

Health & Wellness

We provide health screenings for children (including medical, dental, hearing, and vision) and support families with establishing ongoing medical and dental homes. We also provide free diapers & wipes

Parenting Support & Engagement

We partner with families to help them reach their own self-sufficiency goals, and we provide parenting support based on an evidence-based curriculum
